Pursuant to sections 14(1)(a) and 15 of the 2008 Act, a non-offshore generating station with a capacity in excess of 50 MWe is a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project (NSIP). As the proposed development is a non-offshore generating station with a capacity of over 50 MWe it is an NSIP under the 2008 Act and it is for this reason that the Applicant makes this application to the Planning Inspectorate.

5. Non-technical description of the Proposed Development

Thurrock Power Ltd proposes to build a flexible electricity generation plant. The plant would have up to 48 engines fuelled by natural gas to generate 600 megawatts of electricity and batteries that can store and allow the facility to export a further 150 megawatts of electricity for four hours (600 megawatt-hours) to the national grid. The development includes construction of a gas pipeline, underground electricity cables, access roads, a causeway, exchange common land and habitat creation.
